ANNUAL REPORT 2021-22

Navjyoti Manovikas Kendra is a school for special needs children. It is working for the welfare of children suffering from Autism, Intellectual and Developmental Disability, Cerebral Palsy and Multiple disabilities. We strongly believe that poverty and disability does not come in the way of realizing one's latent potential, what is required is proper access to education and opportunity. We have been working on mainstreaming the specially abled children by providing them education, vocational training & employment opportunities depending on the level of their skill and ability. Over our long journey of 33 years, many children & their families have benefited through our efforts.

Navjyoti has emerged as a big hope for the disadvantaged child. We continue to identify & work for economically- socially deprived intellectually disabled children with the aim to make them self-reliant and lead healthy, dignified and sustainable quality of life.

The impact of our intervention is visible in children & families. It is gratifying to see them all changing for the better. There is lot more to be done for them and many more children to be brought into the ambit.

At present we are having **104** students who are taking benefit of educational vocational training along with extracurricular activities & therapeutic help. Every child in the school gets regular training for learning functional academics (reading, writing, number concept, time & money concept, assessment of mass & volume), pre- vocational, vocational training, extracurricular activities like dancing, singing, sports, craft making etc according to the interest of the child.

Other than functional academics & vocational training, children undergo regular training for Art of Daily Living skills. Our children are also getting exposure for learning academics through Interactive Board.

We have Physiotherapy center managed by qualified physiotherapists where children are being treated as per their conditions and needs on 1:1 basis.



To make the learning more fun and easier we have "SMART CLASS" system – where students are showed rhymes, videos and movies over a projector.



Every last Saturday of the month a doctors' team from AIIMS, Jodhpur visit us for health checkup and consultation of our school children. Parents are also consulted and guided by this team of doctors.



Admission:

Every new student brought for admission undergoes a detailed examination and assessment by our experienced and qualified rehabilitation team and special educators. After this the child is sent to our physiotherapist for any neuromuscular or orthopedic deformity. A detailed evaluation of functional level is being done and then only the placement takes place.

The criterion of distribution of the children in class rooms is based on the basis of their IQ score and chronological age. Majority of our children in the school are distributed according to their mental ability as well. Each child's educational program is made on the basis of their IQ and functional ability. Each classroom has strength of 8 to 10 students to assure personal attention of the teachers and easy learning.

The school starts at 9:00 am with morning assembly – where students pray, dance, sing rhymes and hymns, do yoga. After this classroom wise, the students engage in different activities. After recess every child gets exposure to pre- vocational and vocational activities as per their interest, skills, and abilities.

The vocation is finalized by the vocational instructors after observing the child's aptitude, ability, skills, interest and physical condition.

At present there are the following vocational activities are available:

- 1. <u>CHALK MAKING:</u> chalks are made by the older male students under the supervision of a vocational trainer. The final product is being sold to majorly the educational institutes.
- 2. <u>ART & CRAFT:</u> our students have a good hand on envelope making, paper bags, greeting cards, diyas, Mala, folders etc. Children under this vocation also make flower garlands, Rakhi's, bandanwars, curtain hangings, artificial jewelry, friendship bands, kakandora etc. all these items are highly in demand.
- 3. <u>CANDLE MAKING:</u> Our students are trained to make variety of candles (floating candles, gel candles, candles with different shapes and sizes). Candles are made with a lot of precision and while abiding by safety measures.

- 4. **BROOM MAKING:** A few of our children are being trained in making Brooms by a trained vocational trainer in this skill. These brooms are further sold to various shops, schools, institutes and households.
- 5. <u>CHOCOLATE MAKING:</u> Recently we have started making handmade chocolates in school. Under the guidance of vocational trainers our children have started making variety of chocolates, which is good in demand.
- 6. <u>HANDICRAFT AND PAINTING WORK</u>: Few of our children have very good hand over painting and handicraft items. They paint diyas, envelopes, paper bags etc. and then with their creative mind they decorate these items.
- 7. **<u>DETERGENT MAKING</u>**: we also have students who make detergent powders under the assistance of trained teachers. The quality of detergent is very good along with nominal price, has got a good demand in market.

All these products are being further sold to different small scale to big scale institutions. We are actively participating in various exhibitions under the guidance of trained and skilled vocational teacher along with the children to sell the products.

We are also conducting mini melas, wherein students from different schools visit us and buy our products.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

For overall child's development every student is a part of extracurricular activities. This not only helps us to identify their interests, abilities but also helps us in making learning more enjoyable.


• Raksha Bandhan (21.08.2021)
